# **Over half** have provided care for at least two years



Over a third have provided care for at least 20 hours per week



# **WHO ARE CAREGIVERS?**

**25%** are 65 years old or older

**35%** are caring for a parent or parent-in-law

23% are providing care to someone with dementia



### **HOW DO CAREGIVERS HELP?**



Over 80% manage household tasks

**Over half** assist with personal care
