1 in 5 adults are caregivers

CAREGIVERS provide regular care or assistance to a FRIEND or FAMILY member with a health problem or disability

CAREGIVING CAN BE

Over half have provided care for at least two years



A third have provided care for at least 20 hours per week



WHO ARE CAREGIVERS?

58% are women

29% are 65 years old or older

33% are caring for a parent or parent-in-law

20% are providing care to someone with dementia



HOW DO CAREGIVERS HELP?



Over 80% manage household tasks

Nearly half assist with personal care
