2021–2022 Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS) Data from American Indian and Alaska Native adults in 47 States and Puerto Rico



1 in 4 American Indian/Alaska Native adults are caregivers

CAREGIVERS provide regular care or assistance to a FRIEND or FAMILY member with a health problem or disability

CAREGIVING CAN BE

LENGTHY

Over half have provided care for at least two years



INTENSE

Over a third have provided care for at least 20 hours per week



HOW DO CAREGIVERS HELP?



Over 75% manage household tasks

Over half assist with personal care



WHO ARE CAREGIVERS?

56% are women

20% are 65 years old or older

28% are caring for a parent or parent-in-law

24% are providing care to someone with dementia



FUTURE CAREGIVERS

1 in 7 NON-CAREGIVERS expect to **BECOME CAREGIVERS** within 2 years
