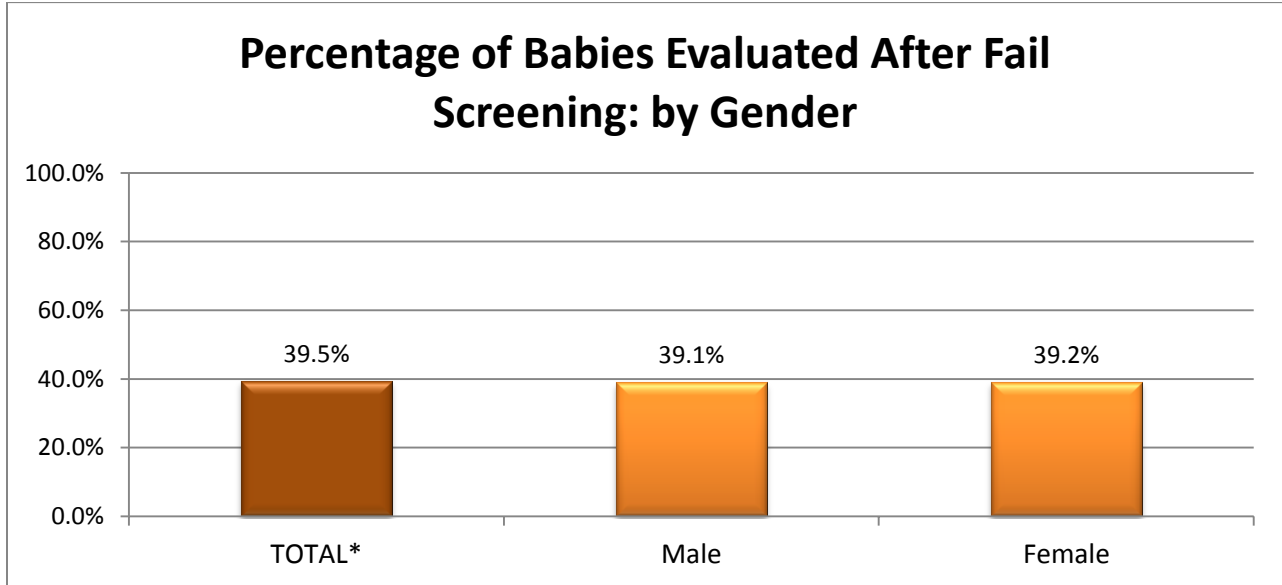
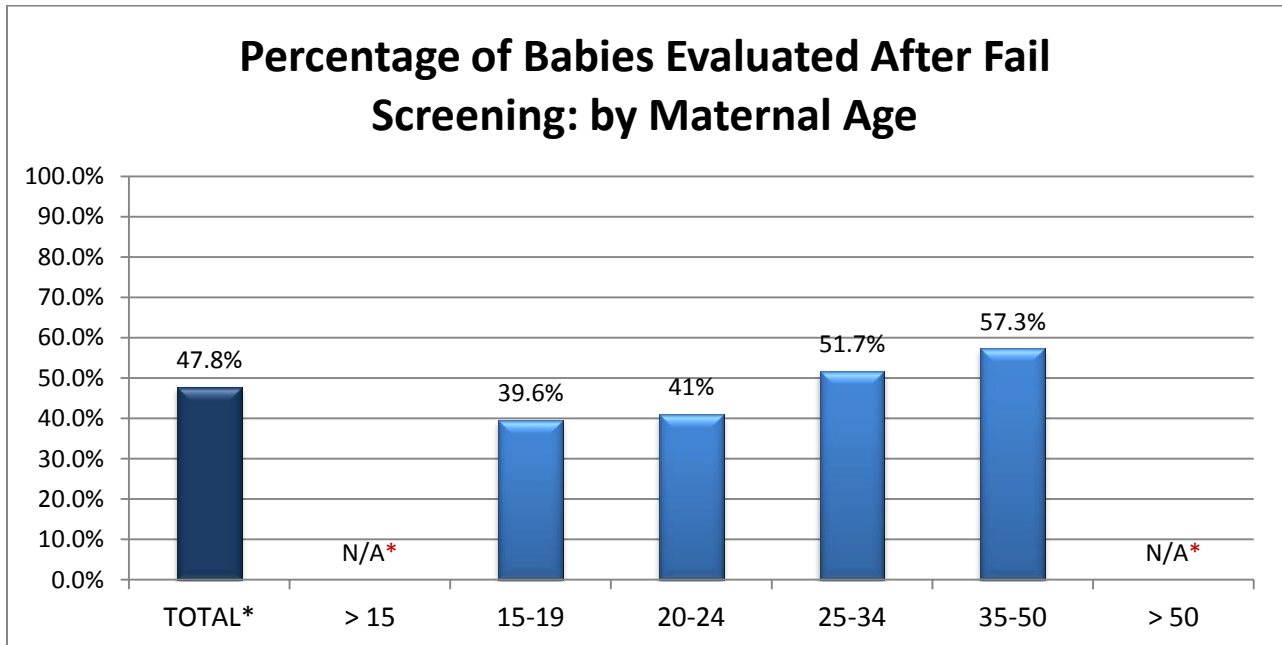

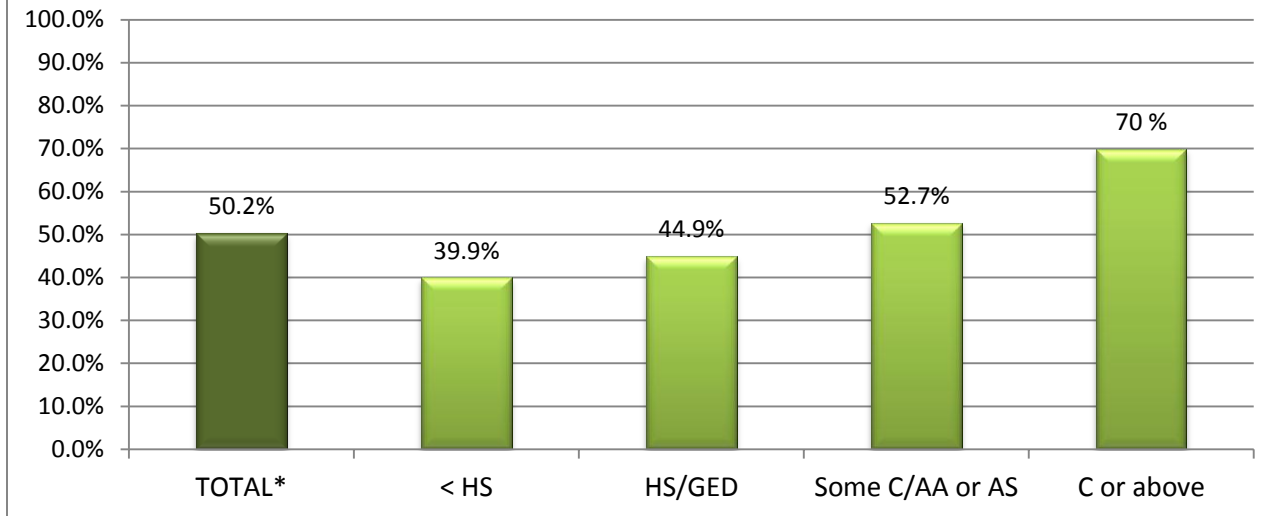

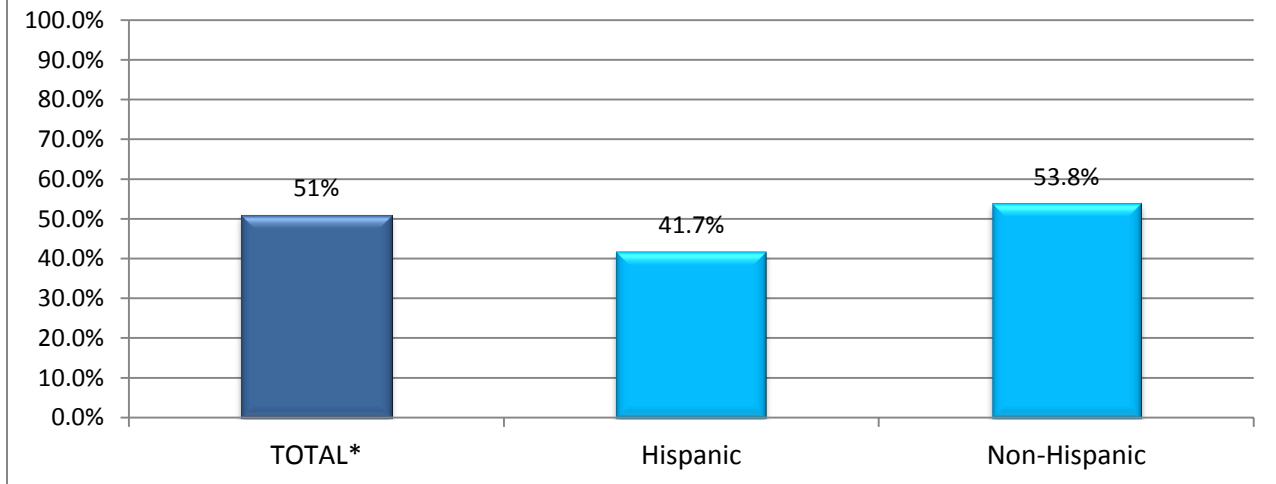
Percentage of Babies Evaluated After Fail Screening: by Maternal Education



HS: High School, HS/GED: High School/General Educational Development, C/AA or AS: College/Associate of Arts or Associate of Science

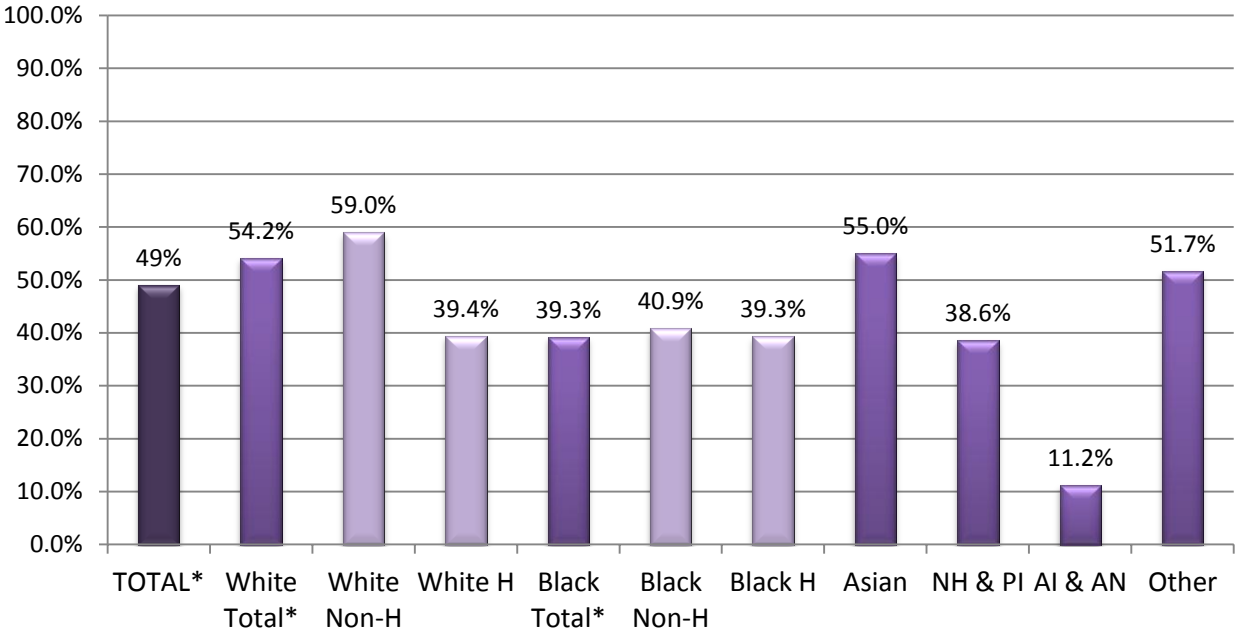
