Formula

Prevalence: # Diagnosed with hearing loss / Total screened x 1,000

Total Diagnosed Before 3 Months of Age: (# Diagnosed with normal hearing + # with permanent hearing loss before 3 months) / (# Diagnosed with normal hearing + # with permanent hearing loss)
