Module 2 Video Scene

[Title card appears: **Cut to the Point: Write for Immediate Understanding.** 1950's string music plays.]

[Spooky music plays]

[Two trucks have collided at an intersection — a dump truck is on its side, spilling green rocks on the road. A flatbed's cargo — a silver flying saucer, partially revealed by a detached tarp — is leaking black fluid.]

NARRATOR: Great Scott! A dump truck full of blurgletanium has crashed into a tractor-trailer carrying a mysterious silver disc! It's an **environmental health calamity**!

[The black fluid and green rocks combine to form a glowing ooze.]

[People with 1950s clothes and hair stand around motionless as the ooze moves towards them.]

[Chimes sound as messy documents appear in the people's hands.]

NARRATOR: Thank goodness the mayor has given the citizens a guide for just this sort of emergency.

[Shot of a hand scanning down the complex document's table of contents, pages turning.]

NARRATOR: But...it looks a little wordy.

[Tense music plays]

NARRATOR: These unfortunate people can't possibly read this fast enough.

[Close up on people's anxious faces, which are now perspiring.]

[The hand continues to scan through the document's long list of appendices.]

NARRATOR: Oh no — Appendix Z! Oh! Who can save the citizens from this tragic lack of concision?

[Shot of townspeople reading the document as the ooze nears.]

NARRATOR: Are they all doomed to be absorbed by the insatiable ooze?

[Triumphant music plays as Gary appears.]

NARRATOR: It's Gary! Paragon of clear communication principles!

[Tense music plays.]

[Shot of Gary writing hurriedly on the complex collection stack paper.]

NARRATOR: Looks like Gary's doing a quick edit! But will he finish in time?

[Shot of a clock tower with the hands turning quickly as the ooze rises in the bottom of the screen.]

[Gasps as Gary holds up a sheet of paper that reads, "Run Away!"]

[Shot of a sidewalk and scrambling feet as people run away. Light piano trill as a dog passes.]

[Clapping and cheering.]

NARRATOR: Phew!

[A hill overlooking the town. In the foreground, the document and citizens stand happily. In the middle ground, the dog floats on a piece of wood within the ooze.]

NARRATOR: Thanks to Gary's concise environmental health advice, the citizens are saved!

[In the background, the ooze grasps the clock tower and tears it down.]

NARRATOR: And next time you write an environmental health document for consumers, remember to
