

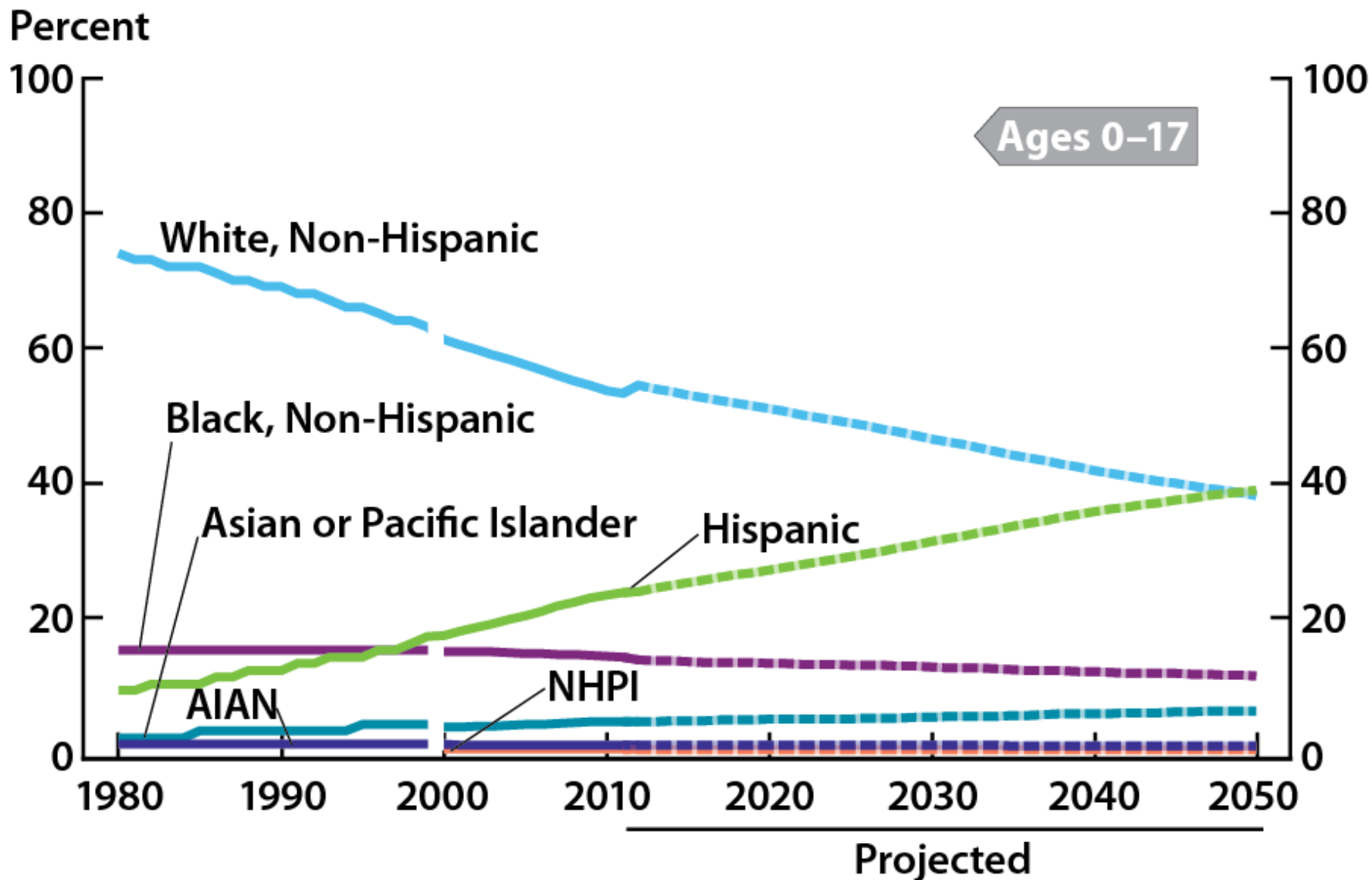
America's Children: **Key National Indicators of Well-Being**

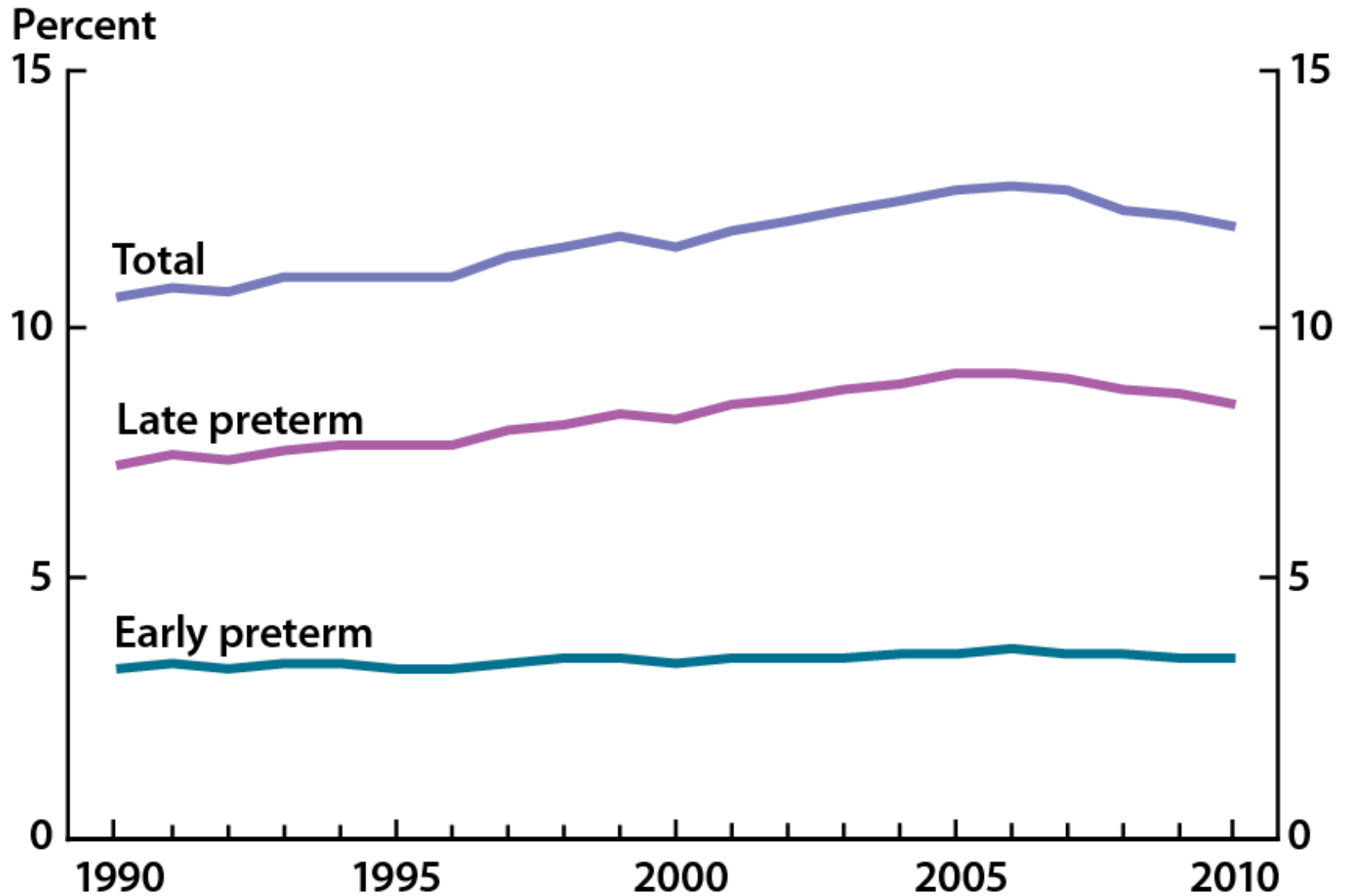

Children by Race and Hispanic Origin (projected 2012–2050)



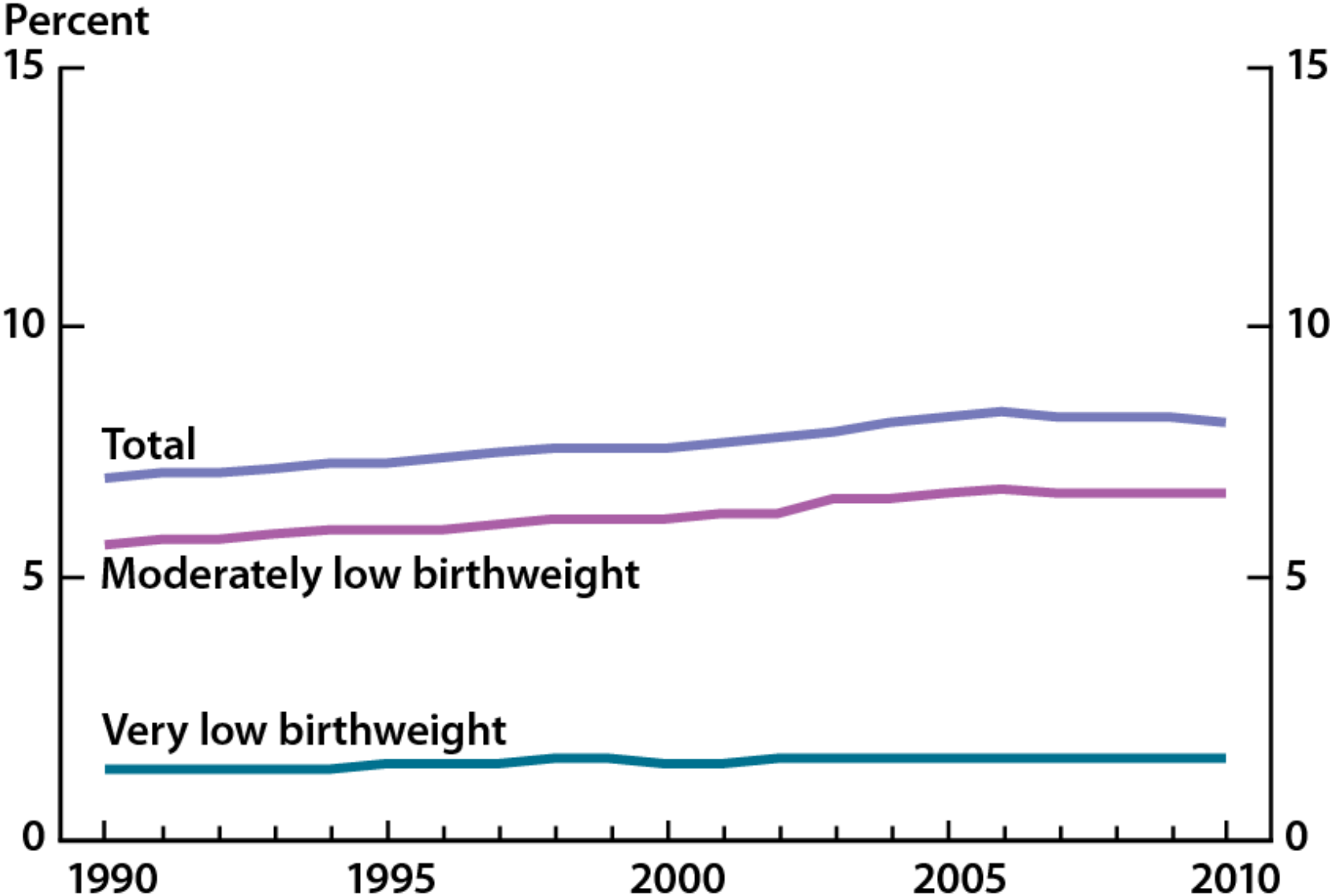

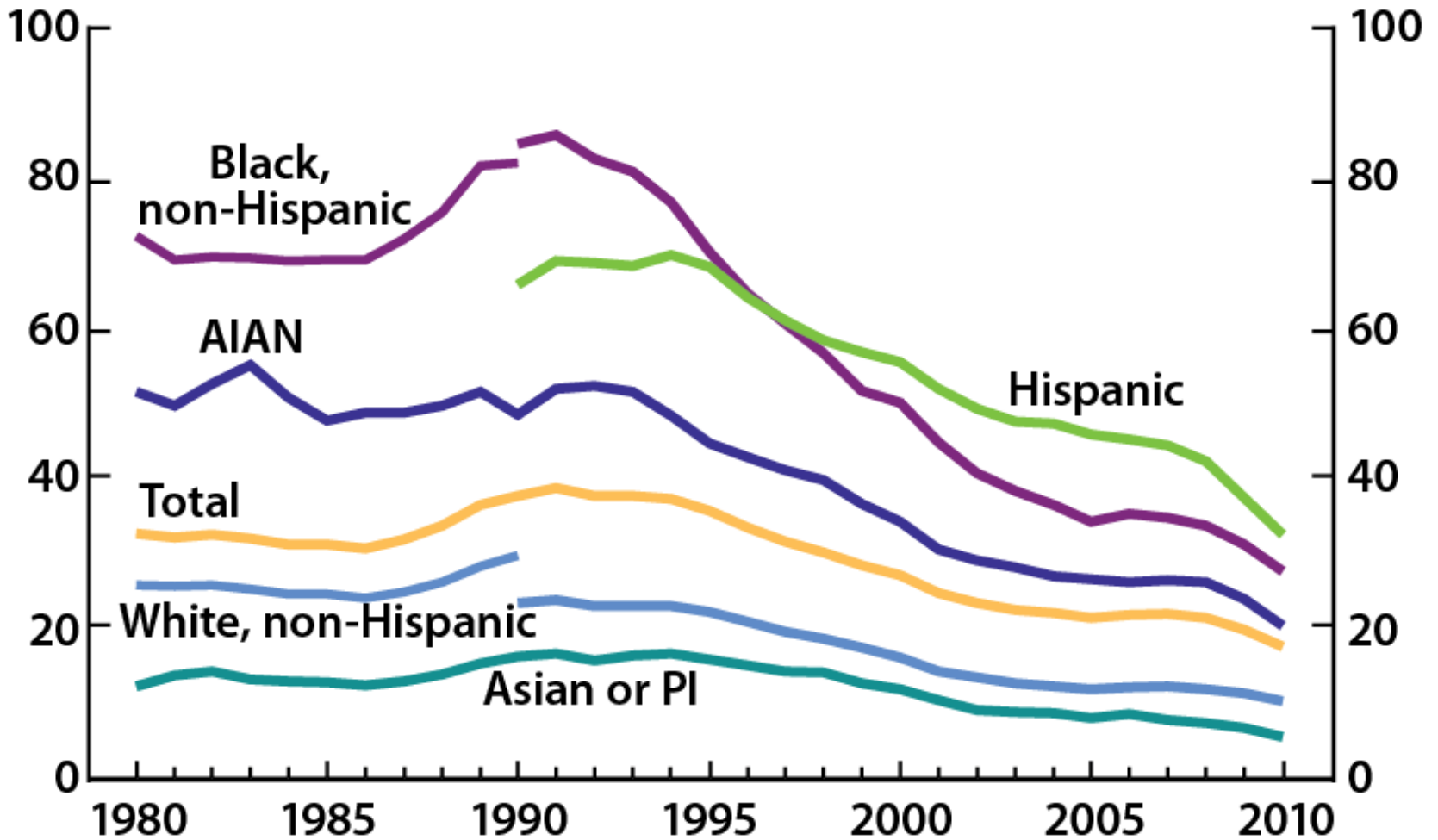
Infants Born with Low Birthweight

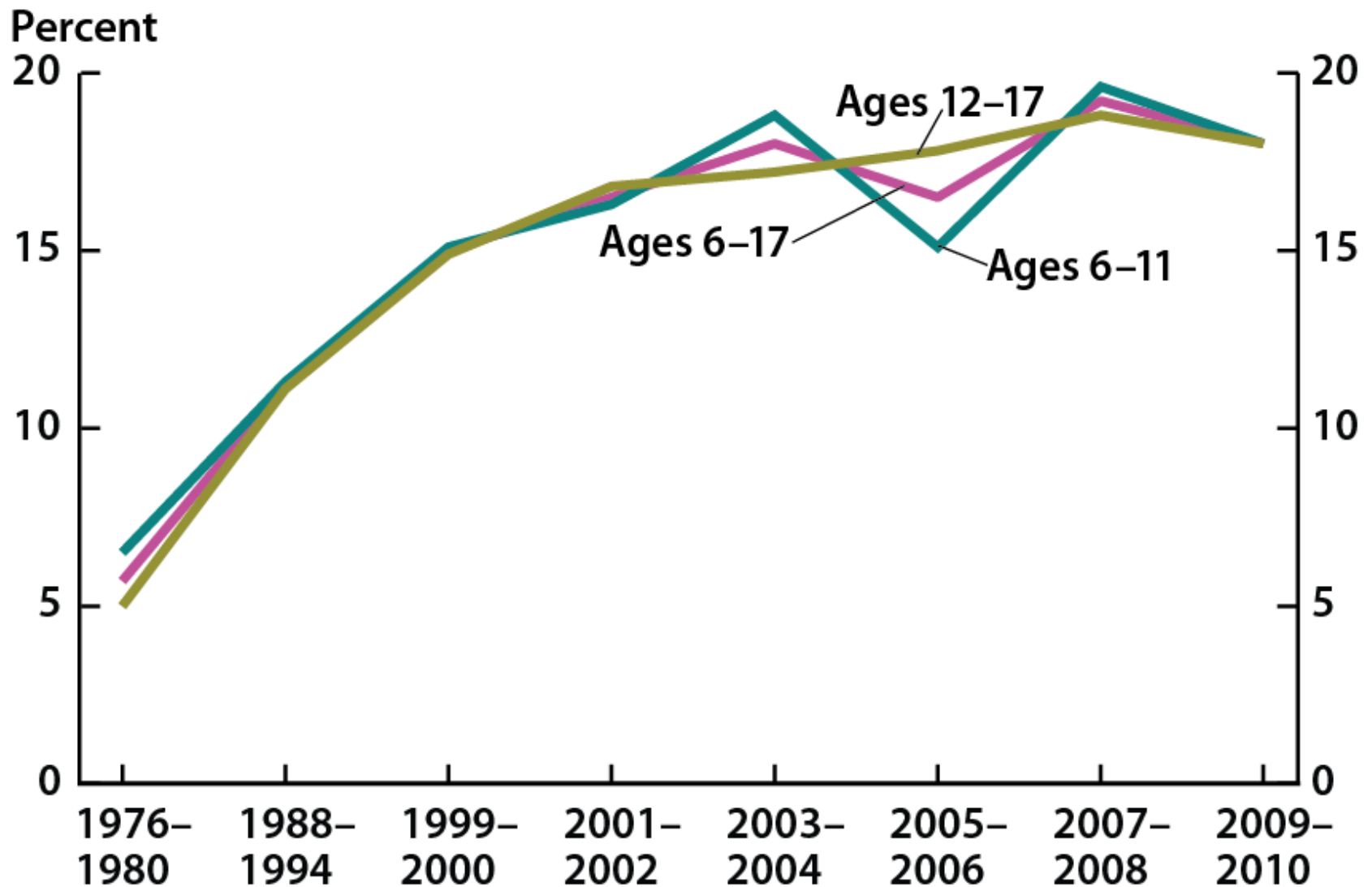
Teen Birth Rates

Live births per 1,000 females ages 15–17



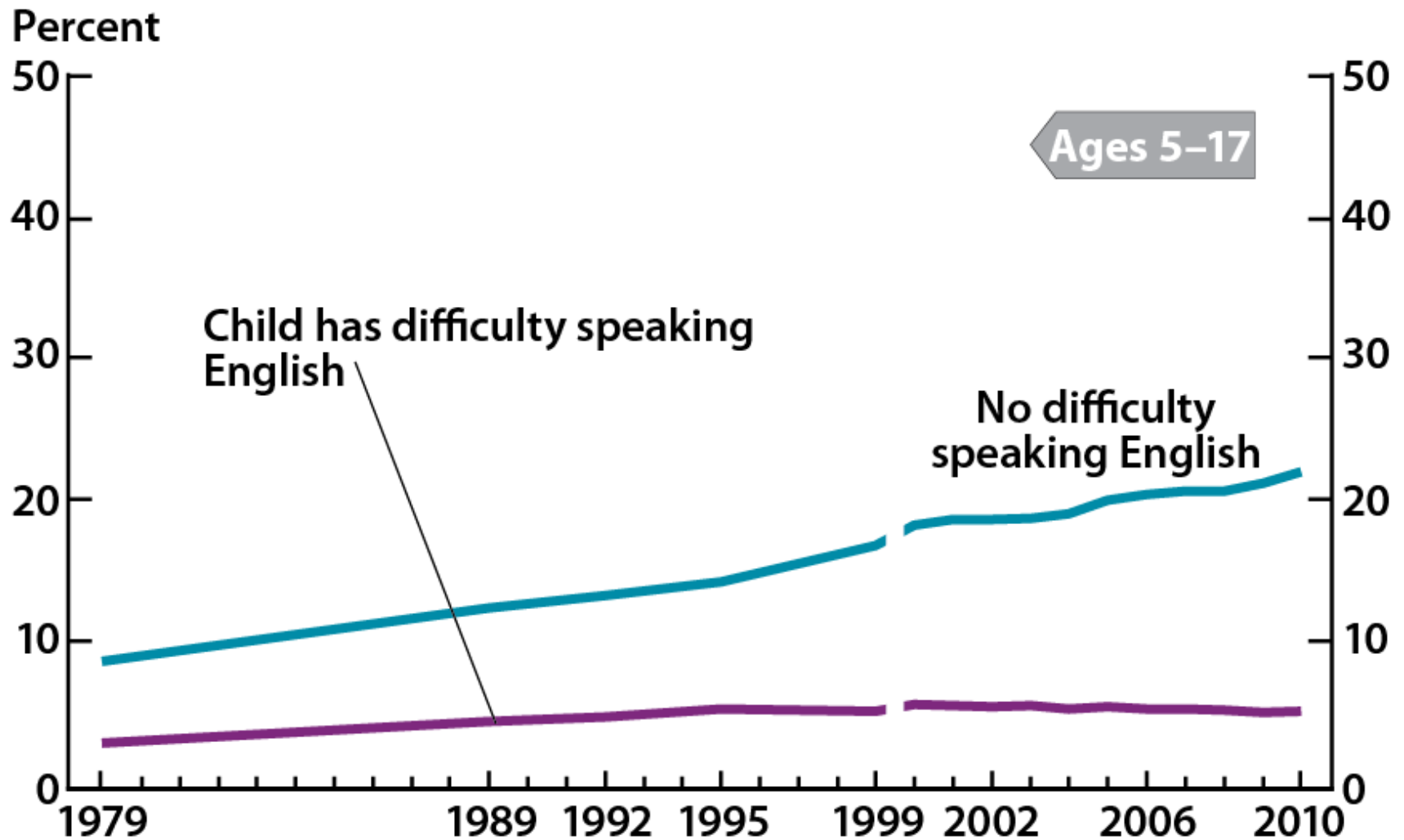

Children with Obesity



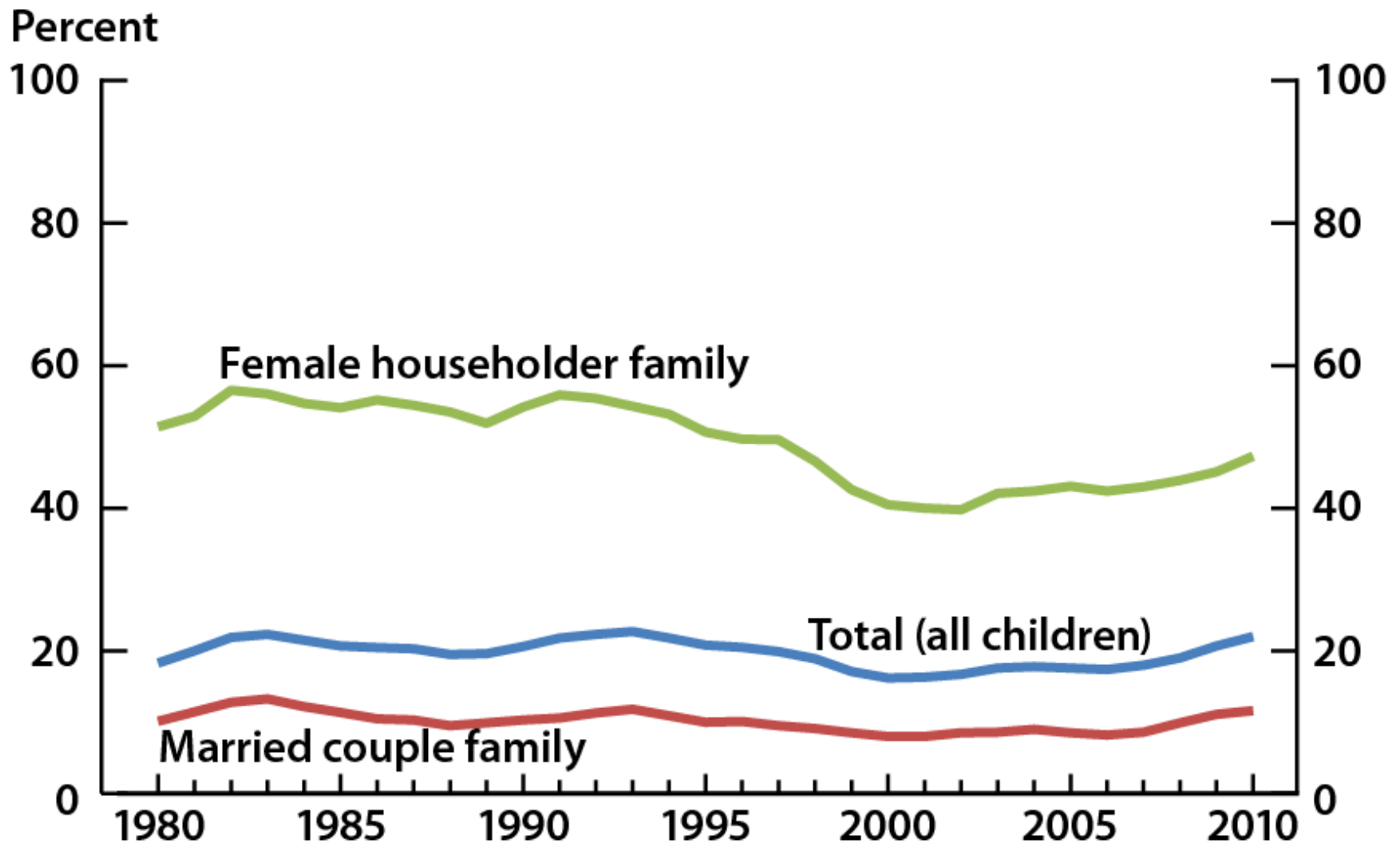

Children in Non-English Speaking Households



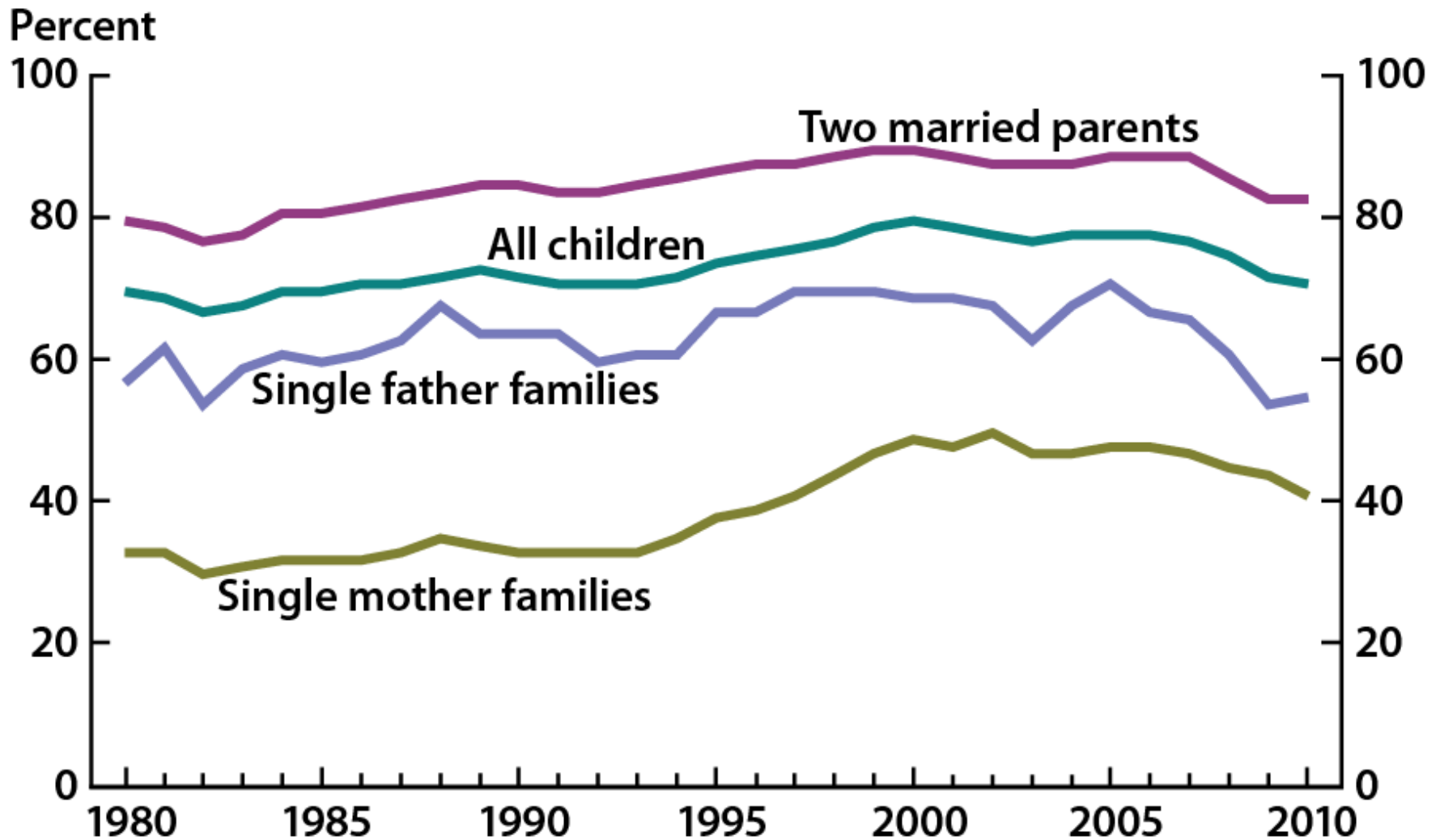

Children Ages 0–17 Living in Poverty



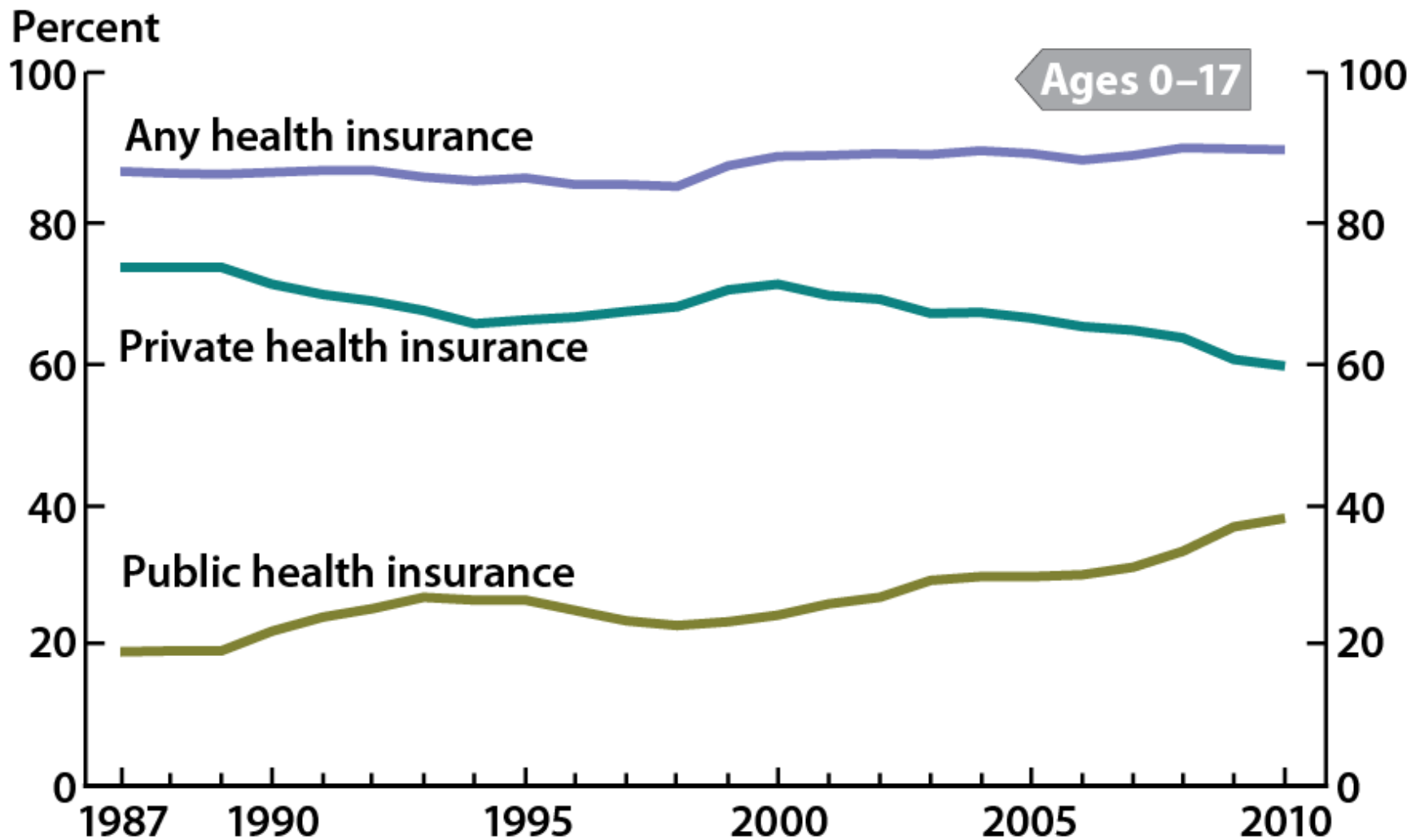

Children Living with at Least One Parent Employed Full Time, Year Round

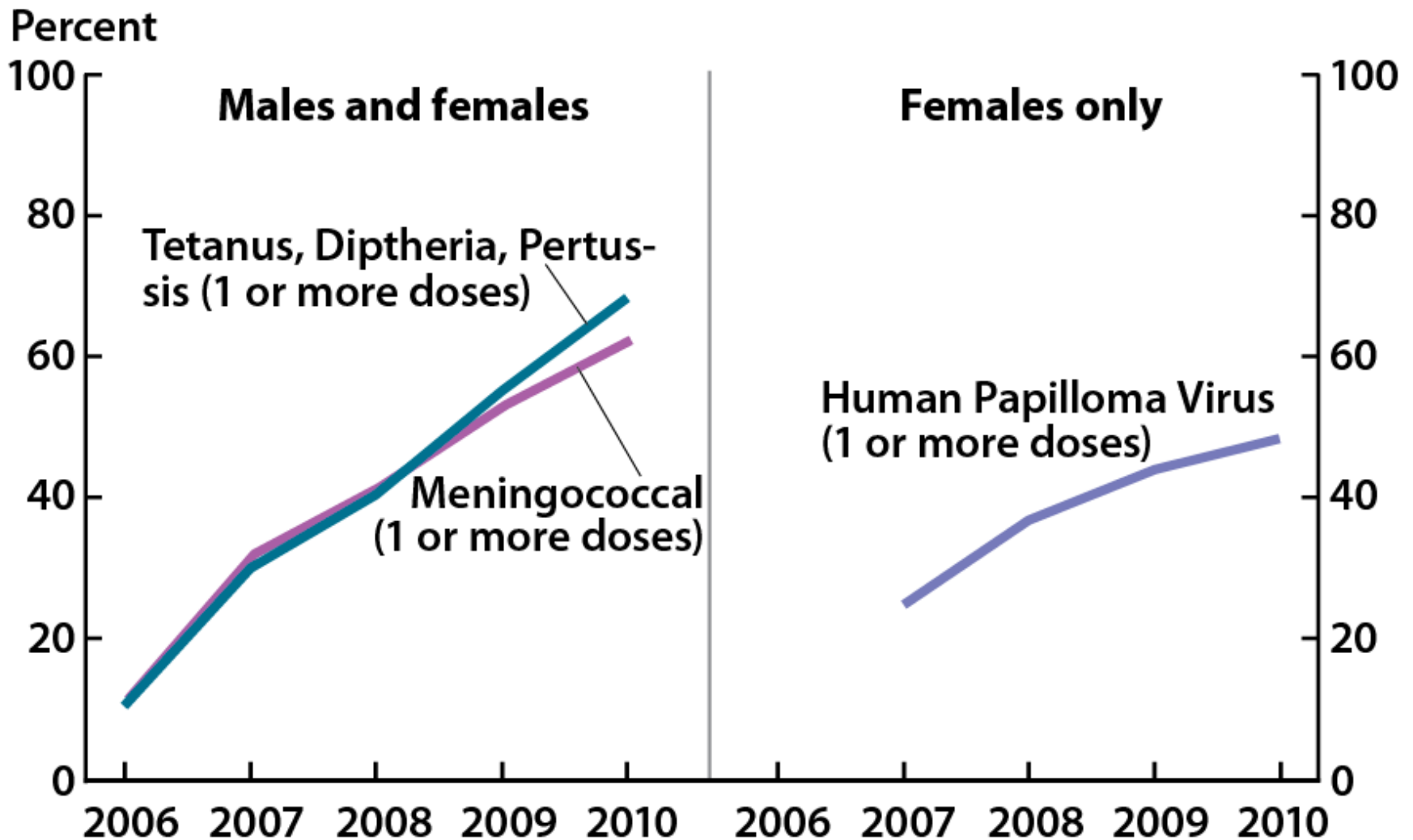

Health Insurance Coverage Any time During the Year

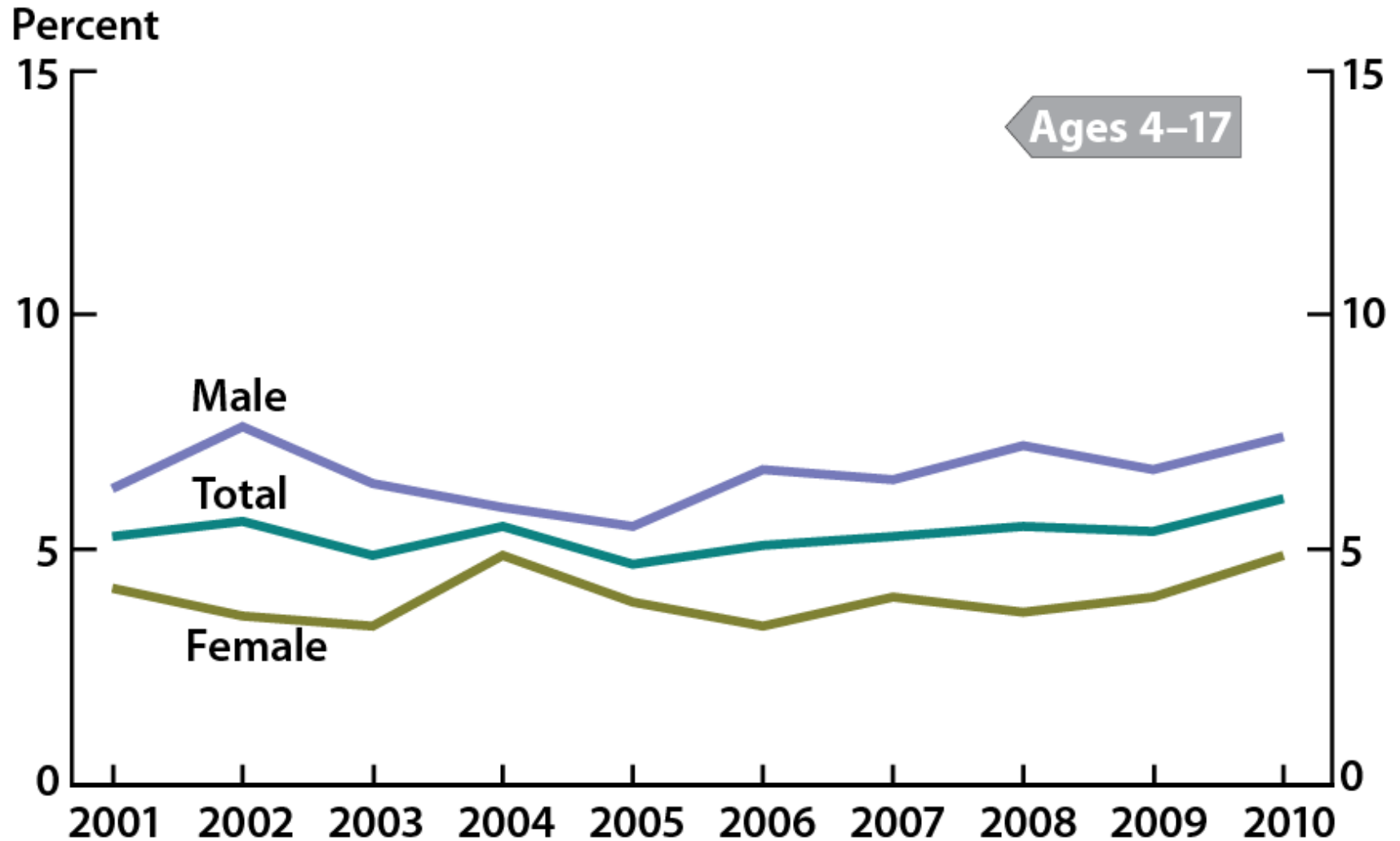


Adolescents Ages 13-17 Receiving Recommended Vaccinations



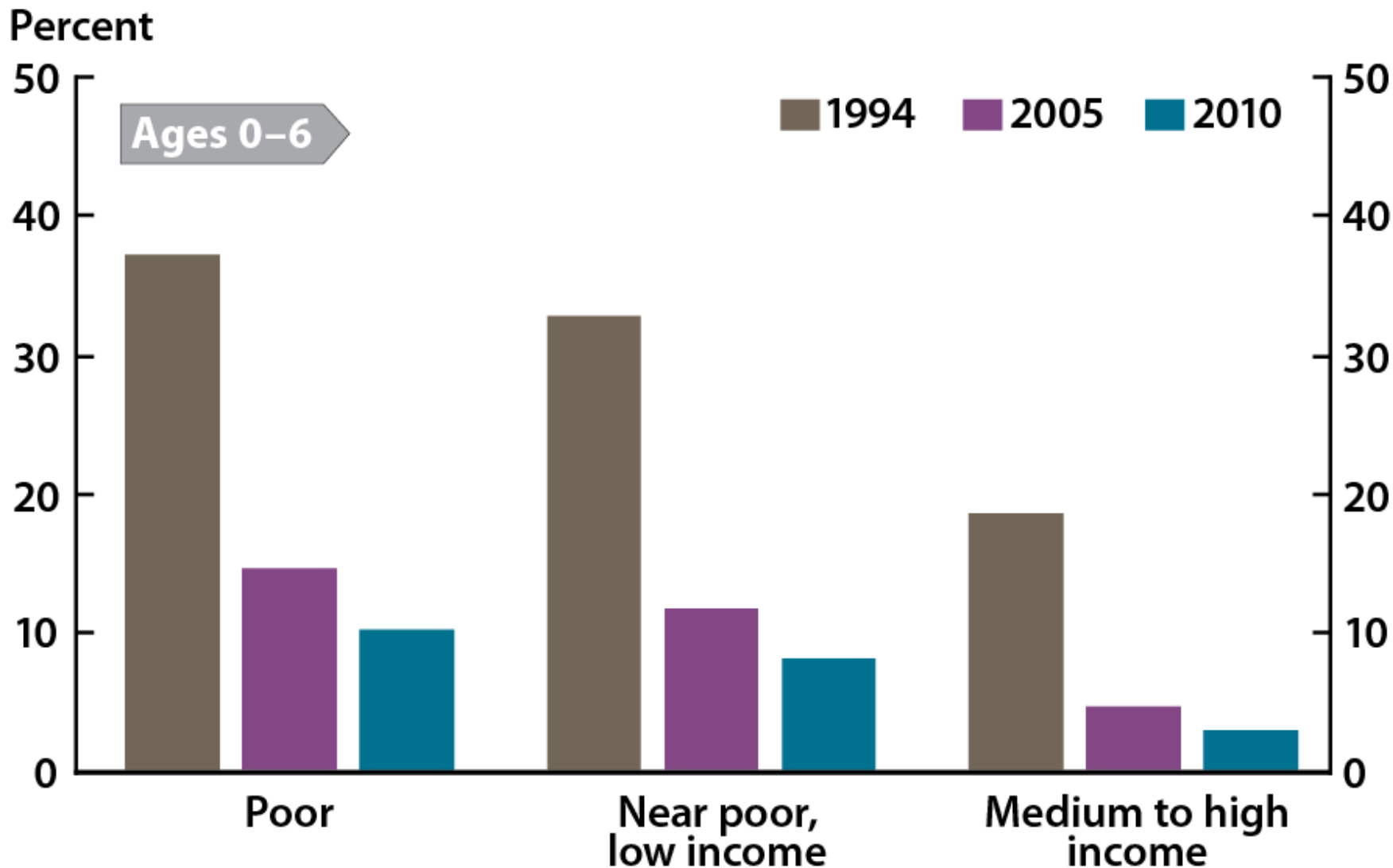

Children with Serious Emotional or Behavioral Difficulties



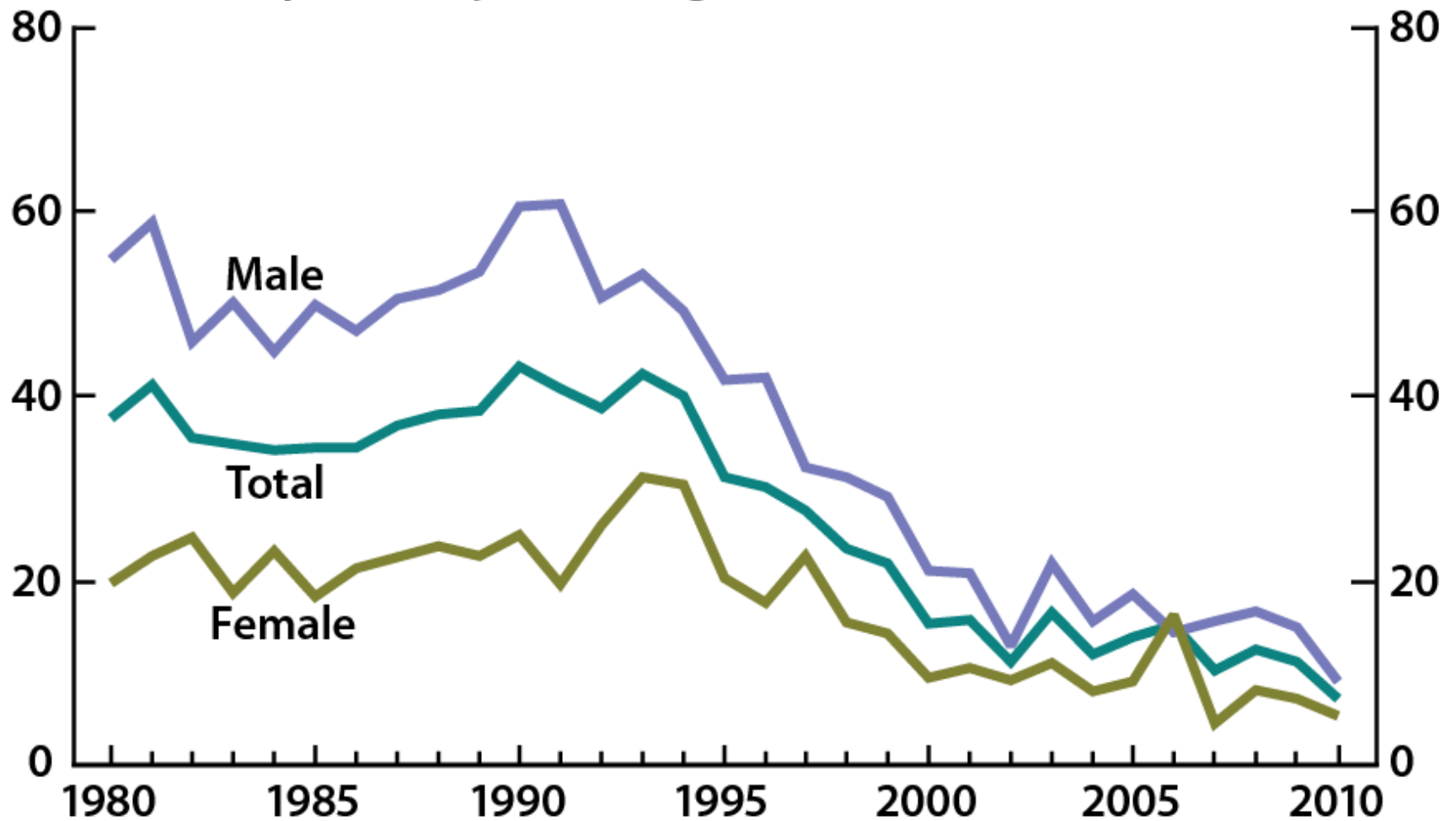

Youths as Victims of Serious Violent Crimes

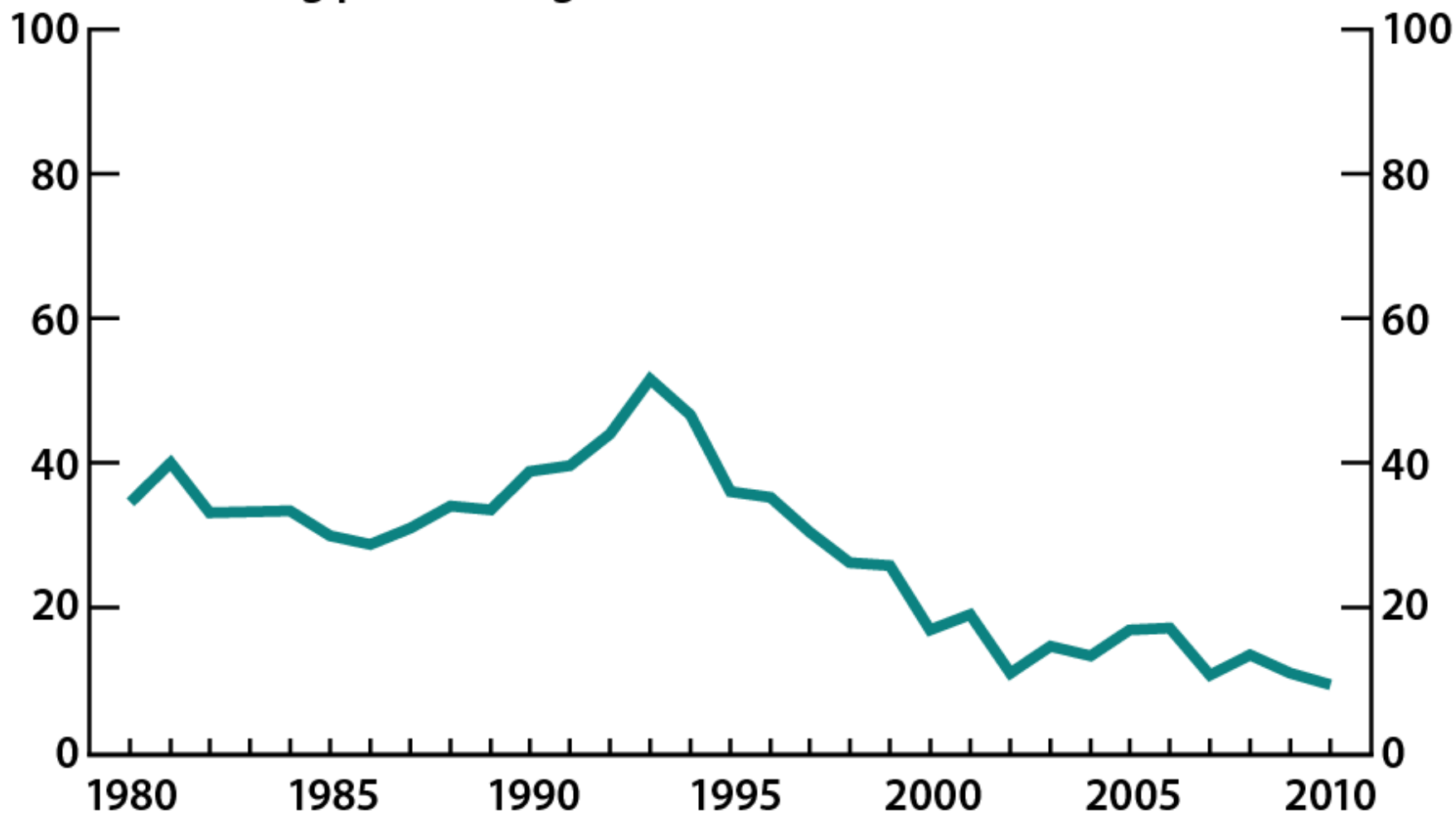
Youth victims per 1,000 juveniles ages 12-17

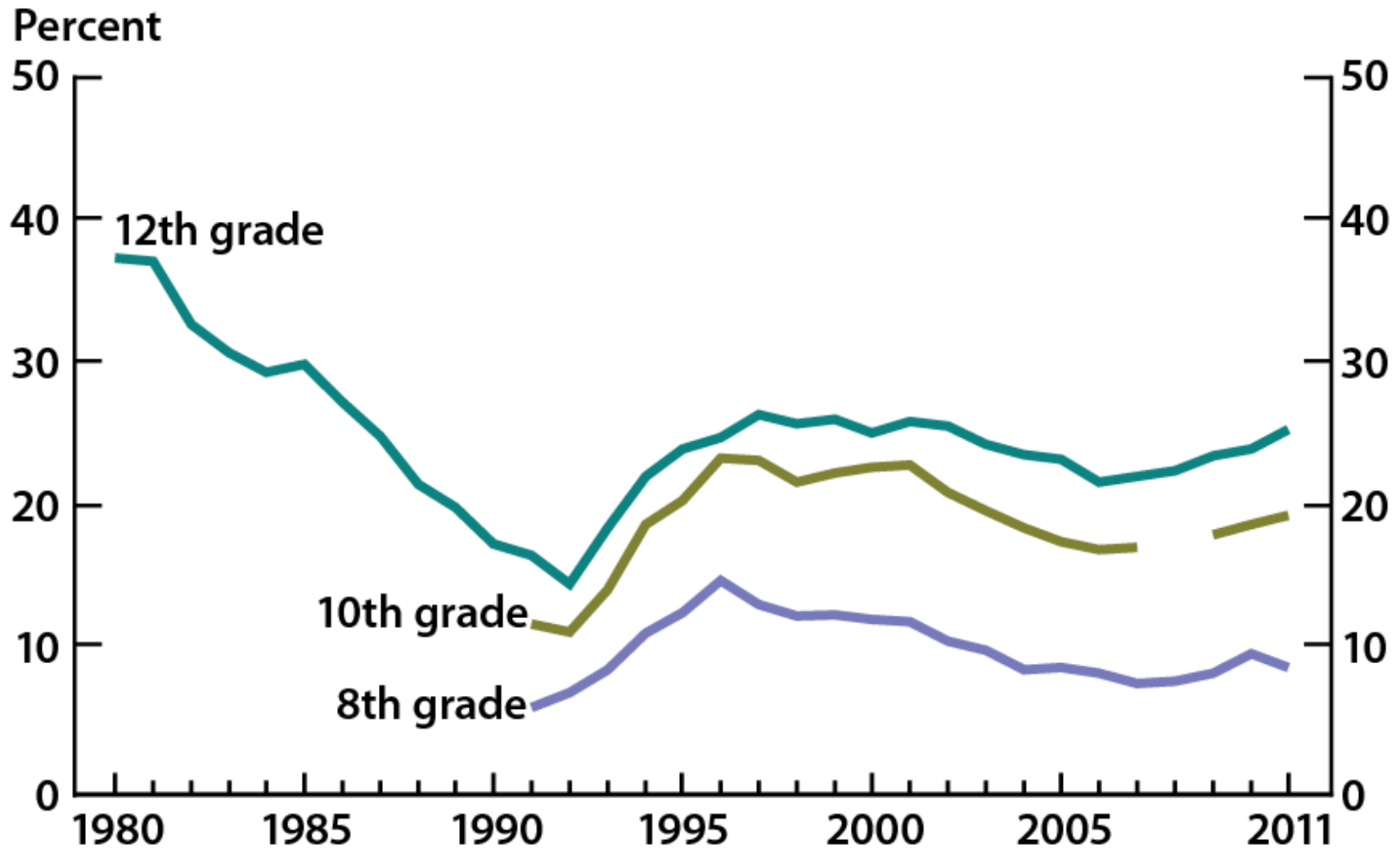
Youths Committing Serious Violent Crimes

Youth offending per 1,000 ages 12-17



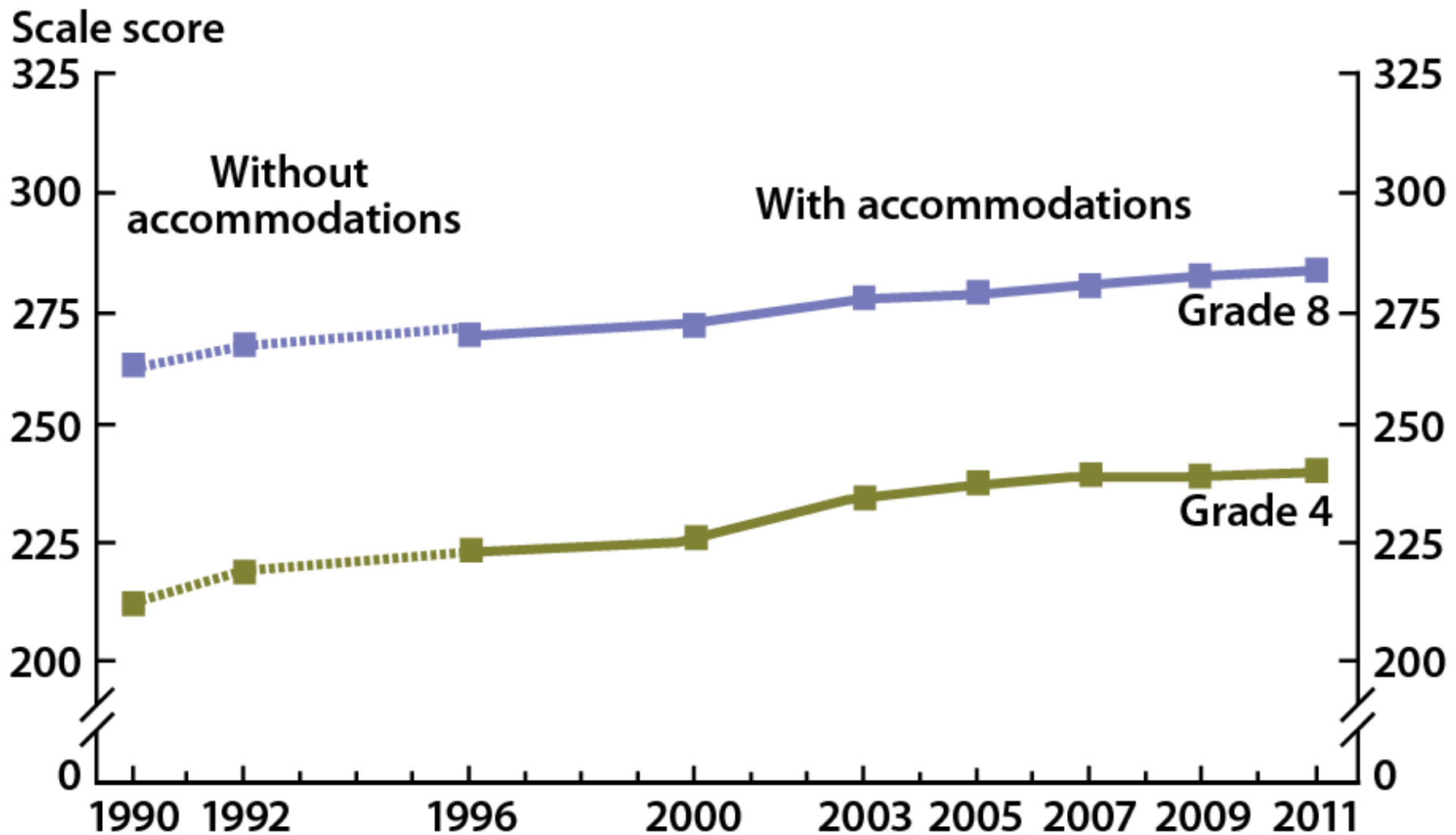

Illegal drug use in the past 30 days



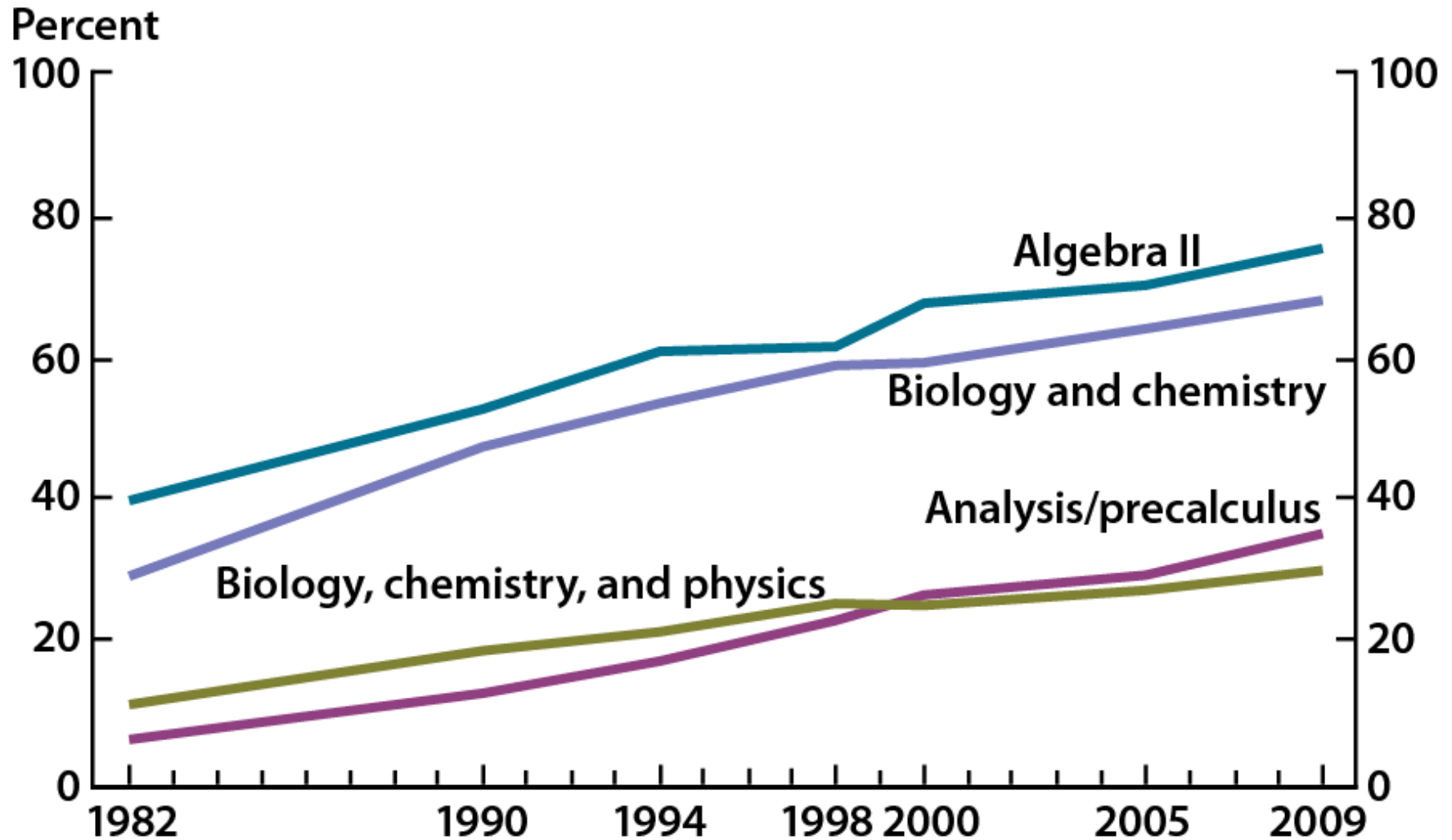
