

OUTPATIENT PROCEDURE COMPONENT: SAME-DAY OUTCOME MEASURES

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION: The goal of this web-based activity is to educate Ambulatory Surgery Center (ASC) healthcare providers on the Outpatient Procedure Component Same-Day Outcome Measures (OPC-SDOM) protocol and application of the OPC-SDOM protocol in order to improve patient outcomes in the ASC environment related to falls, burns, wrong events and direct admissions to a hospital from an ASC.
