I use the NIOSH reports in recreating the incident (using photo taken here in Phoenix, house, apartments, commercial,?) and making a simulation that plays out of command officers and captains. Then use the report to talk about incident, response, and action issues. It serves as a great tool for re-enforcing issues and actions.

Some things to consider:

1. Make reports consistent (drawings, photos etc.
2. Include radio traffic
3. more details (PPC, type, age, possible number of washing, type under garment) SCBA /PASS(age, service/maintenance interior/exterior) boots  
rubber/leather.
4. Drawing show the "rule of nine" burns of victim/location (if cause of death)
5. Dept. training as it relates to incident (vent.class (3hrs), hose line ops.(3)hrs) in the last year.
6. Experience of IC
7. Org./flow chart of the incident
