I represent the 20,000 people who lived there while the municipal drinking water was contaminated with high levels of TCE. The EPA states that the level of TCE in the wells when they were closed was ~ 380 ppb. We drank this water, swam in it in out back yard pools, showered in it --- from the time we were in kindergarten through high school graduation and some of us into college. Now my friends and I are dead and dieing. We have non-hodgkins lymphoma, liver cancer, thryoid problems, skin rashes, nervous conditions, MISCARRIED BABIES WHO WERE NEVER BORN, all kinds of diseases you wouldn't expect to find killing 40 year olds...

The results are in. TCE causes cancer, autoimmune diseases, neurological problems, infant death and disease...do something to help these people who were exposed at work to get the health evaluations and care they need. Please.
