Occasionally, I was assigned the dreaded work station of moving bundles of PCB's in-the "degreasing" operation which ran a open spray of trichlor on a conveyor line. After working this 8-hour shift (frequently 4 hours mandatory overtime), I would become very agitated, throwing empty plastic PCB containers. Working at this station was done without any protective breathing apparatus.

Should I be concerned of long term health effects from my exposure while working at minimum wage at this time?
