Hi

I was writing to inquire if you have thought of including workers who spent a great amount of time working at IBM who were NOT IBM employees. For example, my husband was an [redacted] the late [redacted]. He spent close to a year working in the [redacted] of the IBM Endicott buildings doing [redacted] work. In [redacted] at the young age of [redacted] he was diagnosed with Stage II Renal Cell Carcinoma (Kidney Cancer). It is rare for a man that young to get RCC. He does not smoke or have a family history of cancer. The doctor [redacted] told us that his cancer had been growing approx 10 years - so it is likely that he was exposed to something around the late [redacted] s or early [redacted] s. At this time he is cancer free, but continues to be scanned every six months for the rest of his life, as it is possible for this cancer to return at any time. I am just asking for you all to consider the guys that worked in the [redacted] of the buildings, who aren't on an IBM employee list.
