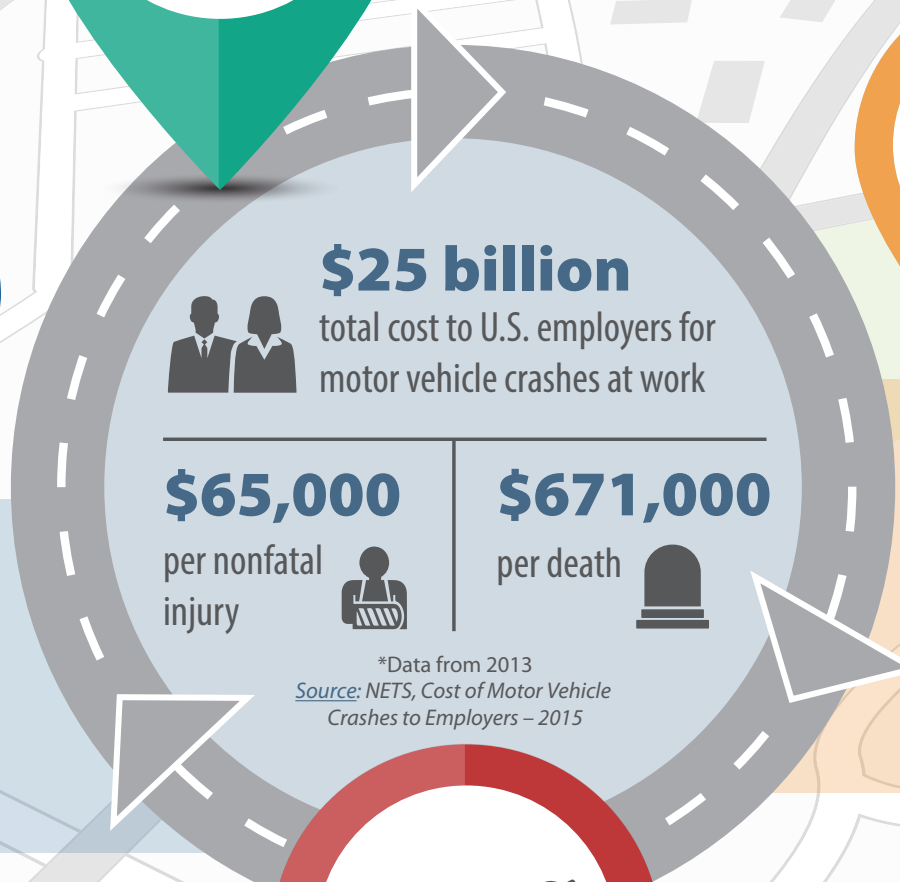
The goal of the **Center for Motor Vehicle Safety** is to make sure that those who work in or near vehicles come home safely at the end of their workday.
