

**Madison Site (Speculite)
1957-1960 & 1992-1998**

Summary Description	
<p>The Madison Site is listed as an Atomic Weapons Employer (1957-1960) and a Department of Energy facility (1992-1998) under EEOICPA. Dow Chemical operated the facility under subcontract to Mallinckrodt Chemical Company. Dow received a purchase order from Mallinckrodt in March 1960, for research and development on the extrusion of uranium metal and rod. There is no evidence to support the DOE facility dates for remediation.</p>	
Supporting Documents	
1960	<p>A January 16, 2000, FUSRAP database report explains that Mallinckrodt issued a purchase order to the Madison Site for R&D on the extrusion of uranium metal and rod. The report claims that the facility performed work for the AEC in the late 1950s, but provides no additional explanation or evidence.</p>
1992-1998	<p>An Office of Worker Advocacy FUSRAP Data Analysis finds no justification for the 1992-1998 DOE designation. No record of remediation exists.</p>
