

World Trade Center 9.11 Health Program Survivor Benefits



As a survivor of 9/11, you could be eligible for medical monitoring and treatment through the World Trade Center (WTC) Health Program. Join the over 44,000 other members enrolled as Survivors in the Program. As a member, you may be eligible to receive WTC-related health care at no-cost to you.

Monitoring Exams

Survivors can receive one covered initial health evaluation. Once a condition is certified as WTC related, Survivors are eligible for annual monitoring exams.

Mental Health Benefits

The Program covers mental health treatment services for WTC-related mental health conditions such as:

- Therapy and counseling
- Substance use disorder treatment

Pharmacy Benefits

The Program covers prescription drugs used to treat a certified WTC-related health condition through:

- Retail: Up to 90-day supply at retail pharmacies in Express Scripts network AND in primary insurance network
- Home delivery: 90-day supply through home delivery pharmacy in Express Scripts network AND in primary insurance network
- Specialty: Up to 30-day supply at any pharmacy in Express Scripts network AND in primary insurance network

Benefits Counseling

The WTC Health Program offers benefits counseling including:

- Workers' Compensation counseling
- 9/11 Victim Compensation Fund assistance
- Other health insurance counseling
- Social services assistance
- Cancer care assistance
- Non-covered conditions assistance
