


Below you will find general program information related to members enrolled and members certified for treatment of health conditions in the WTC Health Program.

Overall Enrollment: Responders and Survivors*




Note: The Program started on July 1, 2011, and at that time, 56,107 Responders were "grandfathered" from previous Federal activities. On September 29, 2011, 4,712 Survivors were likewise "grandfathered". The chart above depicts enrollment from the beginning of the Program, starting with "grandfathered" members and the cumulative addition of new members each quarter. The date labels correspond to the end of the quarter (i.e., Mar 2024 represents cumulative members through March 31st, 2024). The Deceased Members table includes all causes of death, not just deaths from WTC-related conditions

New Enrollees Past 24 Months*



New Enrollees - Responders and Survivors Past 24 Months




WTC Health Program Enrollment by Member Type*





WTC Health Program Member Type by Gender*









Top 10 Certified Conditions*





Top 15 Certified Cancers*












